The Doctoral Internship Program at the Deep Eddy Therapy is designed to be aligned with Deep Eddy Psychotherapy's values thereby creating a warm, inclusive, and connected culture to provide doctoral interns with a focused and intensive experience in various clinical modalities, including opportunities to provide therapeutic services such as individuals, couples, groups, including intake assessment and various consultative support with experts in the practice. The internship consists of in-person services, supervision, training didactics, and support. Those who are interested in gaining assessment training and experience may not be the best fit.

A minimum of 400 direct contact intervention hours is required. Applicants must also have completed all their coursework for a doctorate in psychology from an APA-accredited clinical or counseling psychology program, dissertation proposal approved by application deadline, and passed all comprehensive or qualifying exams. The internship program is a clinical psychology internship program and is limited to doctoral candidates who have a one-year full-time internship as a part of their degree requirements.
